Data Overview								The CMC Data Overview provides a range of CMC statistics, by CCG to which each patient belongs, and is sent to all users monthly. Information is largely broken down by patient's recorded GP, but the report includes a breakdown of care plan creators by professional group.
Diagnosis Report								The Diagnosis Report, currently available for Dementia, MND, Lung Cancer and Sarcoma, provides various statistics concerning patients on CMC with the relevant diagnosis.
Data Overview - Individual CCG								The CMC Data Overview - Individual CCG provides a range of CMC statistics for an individual CCG, by practice to which each patient belongs. Information is largely broken down by patient's recorded GP, but the report includes a breakdown of record creators by professional group.
CCG Activity Report								This report provides a breakdown of practice and other team activity for CMC care plans that have been created and finalised/published, and/or viewed, in the last 6 full months.
Practice Statistics by CCG								This report shows the following for each practice in the specified CCG: number of patients with a CMC care plan, number of CMC logins issued, number of patients with specific PPC recorded, number of patients with specific PPD1 and/or PPD2 recorded, number marked deceased, number with recorded place of death, number who met their specified PPD1 or PPD2.
GP Activity Report								The GP Activity Report counts creations/approvals of CMC care plans by individuals with job titles on CMC that specifically identify them as GPs, for a specific parent CCG in a specified date range, with totals by practice. Note that this is about who creates/approves the care plan, not about which GP the patient is registered with. The report also indicates how many of the relevant care plans have been updated (by anyone) since they were added, and how many of the patients have been marked as deceased on CMC (by anyone).

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Inputting Team by Practice, Inputting Team by Practice by Month								The Inputting Team by Practice report indicates, for a specified CCG, which teams are adding each practice's patients to CMC. Inputting Team by Practice by Month provides the same information, but broken down by month of creation of the CMC care plan.
Original Inputter Team Breakdown for Specified CCG								Original Inputter Team Breakdown for Specified CCG breaks down the CMC patients with GPs in the specified CCG to provide counts by month, inputting team type (GP/acute/hospice/hospital/community, also indicating whether Palliative Care or not), and inputting team.
Patient Care Plan Creation Report								This report shows the patients added to CMC in the specified date range: 1) by practices in the selected CCGs 2) by non-practice teams and having GPs in the selected CCGs Care plans are listed by originating team type, originating team, originating user and date added; they are listed whether or not migrated to the new system. Exception information is included for each patient. There is an option to include deaths information, but be aware that the report becomes Patient Identifiable if this option is taken.
Nursing Homes Report								This report shows statistics concerning patients in Nursing Homes in the specified CCG(s) who have been added to CMC in the specified month(s).
Patients Created By Practices - Selected CCGs								Patients Created by Practices – Selected CCGs provides statistics concerning CMC care plan creation and deaths at patient GP practice level, across the selected CCG(s).
Patients Added - Selected CCGs								Patients Added – Selected CCGs provides a simple count of patients added to CMC by Year and Month for the selected CCGs.
Mortality Statistics by CCG and Month								Mortality Statistics by CCG and Month provides place of death statistics concerning patients whose GPs are in the specified CCG(s) and who are recorded on CMC or on PDS as having died in the specified month(s).

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Care Plan View Statistics by Year and Month								This report counts care plan views recorded on CMC as occurring in the specified month(s), for patients of the specified CCG(s), with totals by team type.
Demographic Statistics								The CMC Demographic Statistics report provides demographic statistics (CCG, age band, ethnicity, method of consent, diagnosis, prognosis, PPD1/2, PPC, Actual Place of Death, gender) concerning CMC patients whose care plans have been created or updated by the specified team within the specified date range. It also optionally provides care plan counts per individual creator within that team.
Individual User Login Statistics								CMC Individual User Login Statistics shows, for a specified team, a list of CMC users associated with that team, with number of times logged in, and date of most recent login.
CMC Review Information								This report shows the level of view and edit activity for specific care plans, identified by internal CMC id; it may in particular be used in assessing review requirements. It may be filtered as required by: CCG(s) to whose practices patients are registered; inclusion/exclusion of deceased patients; specific inputting team; specific involved team.
Team Audit Report								The CMC Team Audit Report lists all CMC system accesses by a specified team and month at the individual user/individual care plan level.
Inputting Team Report								The Inputting Team Report shows the number of patients added to CMC by year and month for the selected inputting team.
MDT Involvement Report [Mid Month]								The MDT Involvement Report takes the care plans created by a specified team and counts accesses to them by other teams, by month.
Exception Report by Inputting Team								The CMC Exception Report by Inputting Team provides a summary report by exception type and current planned reviewer, followed by a list of relevant patients by exception type and current planned reviewer.

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Patient Care Plan Accesses by Team								The Patient Care Plan Accesses by Team report counts accesses to CMC care plans, by month, by the specified team, with the ability to show only patients whose GPs are in selected CCG(s).
User Access Report								The CMC User Access report counts different types of access to CMC by individuals within a specified team.
Patient List Report								This Patient Identifiable report lists the following for patients of the selected practice: CCG, GP Practice, On New System?, GP, NHS Number, CMC internal ID, Date added to CMC, Date last updated, Forename, Surname, Gender, Date of Birth, Date of Death on CMC, Date of Death on PDS, Address(es), Contact Details, Diagnoses, PPC, PPD1, PPD2, Originating User, Originating Team, Last Updated User, Last Updated Team, Actual Place of Death, Variance. A range filter is available on Date added to CMC. This report is for operational use only. The four reports listed below are intended for management information use by GP practices.
